Indications for both Acetaminophen and Ibuprofen: Treatment of fever and pain.

Table Notes:

- AGE LIMIT: Don't use Acetaminophen under 2 months of age. Don't use Ibuprofen under 6 months of age unless directed by child's doctor. (Reason: safety not established and doesn't have FDA approval). Avoid multi-ingredient products in children under 6 years of age (FDA recommendations 1/2008).
- DOSAGE: Determine by finding child's **weight** in the top row of the dosage table.
- MEASURING the DOSAGE: Syringes and droppers are more accurate than teaspoons. If possible, use the syringe or dropper that comes with the medication. If you use a teaspoon, it should be a measuring spoon. Regular spoons are not reliable. Also, remember that 1 level teaspoon equals 5 ml and that ½ teaspoon equals 2.5 ml.
- DROPS: infant drops come with a measuring syringe
- BRAND NAMES: Motrin, Advil, generic ibuprofen---Tylenol is brand name for Acetaminophen
- ADULT DOSAGE: 400 mg
- FREQUENCY: Repeat every 6-8 hours as needed for Ibuprofen; Repeat every 4-6 hours for Acetaminophen
